Introductions - went around

<u>Welcome: (PRB)-</u> Policy Review Board Update - an email was sent to management but there wasn't an update on every item on it.

- Package Lockers Package Lockers for UV update: If Covid 19 restrictions are lifted in May, installation will most likely begin in June after drawings and full site visit and plans are completed and approved. If Covid 19 restrictions are still in place, the actual install cannot take place until after restrictions are lifted, so it could potentially take longer. At the earliest will be up around June.
 - UCPD Sean has been delivering packages in Mixed-Used. They're also working on getting a team of people that will deliver packages. They will be wearing masks, gloves etc.
- **Food Pantry/ Refrigerator** Sepulveda refrigerator is installed working on getting key access. Need volunteers in order to continue the success of the program
- **Internet/Slow c**all housing or Spectrum. If needed they are providing MiFI (Hotspot devices) as a temporary solution

- Animal Relief Areas Due to the cost this project is being suspended
- Roommate Policy for- there aren't any ways around it
- Reslife Programming mixed housing

UASRA programming shifts-- Budget reallocations

- 1. Unit Reps don't have any more funds for events. You can apply for the Community Grant Program.
- 2. General Programming.
- 3. Produce Drivers Fund.
- 4. Food for GA.

Biggest increases:

- 1. Incentive budget. We want to reward people who went above and beyond all expectations this year.
- 2. Green Rep Fund. We want to start paying people who are helping out Vivian with the food distribution from Food Cycle LA.

New items:

- 1. Mutual Aid Fund. If there are neighbors in need of any essential groceries, we want to be able to help them out.
- 2. Zoom classes

Voting has passed - 20 yes votes

Due to the current crisis: voting on if needed the reserve is less than \$11,000 **Motion passed with 20 votes**
